

Club Registration and Age Policy

These policies have been designed to:

- help members understand what the processes and procedures are in various circumstances;
- ensure that our Club operates in an open and transparent fashion;
- create equal opportunity to all members;

These set of policies also help the volunteers on the committee to ensure the club runs in a consistent and predictable manner over the years and as the committee members change.

REGISTRATION

- The Committee shall nominate a Player Registration Day each season that shall be at least one month prior to the start of the competition for which teams are to be selected.
- Players wishing to be considered for selection into a team must complete & submit the official Registration Forms before the designated due date.
- All players who submit a Registration Form shall receive a Player Information Kit.
- The Player Information Kit shall at least include:

i) Due date and amount of all fees and levies that are to be paid for the season, including Registration Fees, Training Fees, Netball Victoria Fees and any other fees that may be deemed necessary for that season;

ii) Details of uniform requirements and costs.

Players failing to submit the necessary registration forms before the designated due date may not be selected into a team.

AGE REQUIREMENTS

Participant age is determined as at 31 December of that year.
Minimum age requirements are:

- i. Open Sections - 15 years
- ii. 17 & Under – 15 years
- iii. 15 & Under – 12 years
- iv. 13 & Under – 10 years
- v. Players aged 6-11 years will participate in either NetSetGo or an 11 & Under competition.
- vi. Players under 7 may only participate in training and balls skills sessions (PMNC 10 x NetSetGo sessions)

In competitions where participants are 11 & Under, boys participate unrestricted. Where participants are aged 12 and above, boys may participate where allowed as per the rules of the competition in which the team is entered.
